The Long Term Care Equality Index

The LEI, developed in partnership between SAGE and the Human Rights Campaign, is the first national benchmarking tool for LGBTQ+ inclusion in senior housing and longterm care communities. With free resources, technical assistance and a biennial survey, the LEI helps communities implement, strengthen, and innovate their LGBTQ+ inclusion efforts.

The National LGBTQ+ Elder Housing Initiative

SAGE's NHI assists many housing developers and other stakeholders in creating LGBTQ+ affirming and age-friendly spaces for their communities. The NHI provides technical assistance and support through consultation, resource sharing, and networking between stakeholders. The NHI engages with new stakeholders through conferences and speaking engagements, hosting events on LGBTQ+ elder housing, and partnerships with local LGBTQ+ and aging services organizations.



On the NHI website portal, you will find a national map that showcases LGBTQ+ affirming, affordable housing communities for older adults in states across the country. These are communities that were intentionally developed around the needs of LGBTQ+ older people. Many were developed in partnership with a local LGBTQ+ community organization.
